## Our school will improve student outcomes by:

Action	Approximate Cost
Continuing to provide class teachers with additional release time for collaborative curriculum planning with HOD-C, STLaN and teaching team.	\$11 500
Undertaking targeted professional learning to develop the capability of the school's teaching team as per our Annual Implementation Plan.	\$10 000
Employing additional teaching staff to maximise teacher:student ratios across the school.	\$42 000
Providing class release time for our HAT to lead a team in the development of our Positive Education framework and to provide professional learning to school staff.	\$ 5 500
